**March Mission of the Month is Sleep in Heavenly Peace.**

“ No Kid Sleeps on the Floor in Our Town” Is their motto! Sleep in Heavenly Peace was founded in Kimberly, Idaho in 2012. It provides hand-made bunk beds for children who don't have beds of their own. Every bed is handcrafted and constructed by volunteers willing to donate their time to help children in their community and is funded by generous donations.

Tom Otte's, FdL's Chapter President, shared that last year (2025) 307 beds were delivered. These beds went to children ages 3-17. They were in new home placements, domestic family splits in new housing, fire displacements, rodent and insect displacements, new moves into the community, children aging into the program at age 3, and just coming across children who we've found received their FIRST BED at age 14...multiple instances of this.

For about \$250.00 a bed is created. Nationally the cost is around \$300.00. Our Chapter has some great partners that help us keep our costs slightly lower. This year our goal is to build 400 beds. We are lowering the percentage of “bedlessness” in FdL county. It was approximately 5% when we began 5 years ago, and now it is down to almost 2%. We are growing geographically now covering 33 zip codes which are all of Fond du Lac and all of Dodge Counties, sans Juneau. There will be 6 bed builds in 2026, one has been completed. Shari Grinnell participated in this event.

The bedding donation Dropbox is located inside the FdL County Airport. This is the main source of bedding collection. All bedding has been 100% donated which helps to keep our average cost lower than the national average.

## **Sunday Morning Men's Bible Study**

### ***Ecclesiastes: Chasing after Meaning*** by Bill Syrios and Teresa Syrios

This study was written about a book that takes on life's most difficult questions. As a matter of fact, the very first sentence lays out the author's stunning conclusion, "*Meaningless! Meaningless!*" says the Teacher. "*Utterly meaningless! Everything is meaningless.*" ~*Ecclesiastes 1:2 NIV*

Ecclesiastes is the one book in the Bible that just does **not** seem to fit. What place could such a harsh assertion of *meaninglessness* have in a Scripture that intends to reveal the redeeming work of God in history? Along with the book of Job, Ecclesiastes reminds us that God is bigger, and our life in this world more unpredictable, than we might think. This study invites you to take a realistic tour of life.

All are invited to meet in the Gathering Room following the worship service for some "arm-chair" quarterback discussion, followed by digging into the Scriptures, and of course, great food. Weekly leadership (and food) is shared by class members. New members are always welcome to join!

### **Lenten Study**

#### **Why Did Jesus Have to Die? - The Meaning of the Crucifixion**, by Adam Hamilton

##### **When Words Fall Short, the Cross Still Speaks!**

The Gospel writers saw the Crucifixion (and the subsequent Resurrection) as the climax of God's work in the life of Christ. You cannot understand Jesus without understanding his crucifixion. The New Testament authors didn't settle on one meaning of the crucifixion but instead offered a dozen or more metaphors to explain how it saves, but often without a clear explanation of how Jesus's death accomplishes the saving work they describe. Because of this vagueness, wrapping our minds around the logic and meaning of the cross can cause us to miss the full impact it can have on our daily lives. *Why Did Jesus Have to Die?* is written to help make sense of the crucifixion, to listen for how God might speak to us through it, and that we might say, along with Paul, "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me." (Galatians 2:20). This six-week study began on February 22 and continues through March 29.
